## Quilts featured in Row 7

Carol began sewing clothing, then started quilting with a flip-and-sew log cabin. She was a 4H sewing leader for 10 years. Her math education background drew her to the symmetry and patterns in the Judy Niemeyer/Quiltworx quilts. In 1997 she bought her first Judy pattern, and two queen quilts later became hooked. They are still her children's favorite quilts.



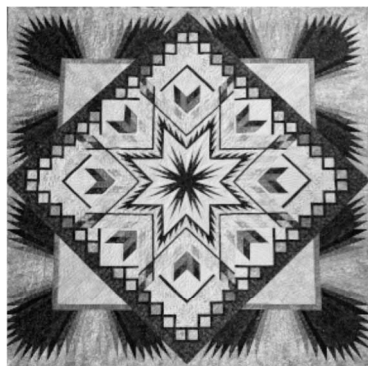
In 2016 she retired from teaching math and leading the Park City Mathematics Institute in Utah. She attended a Judy retreat in Montana as a new challenge. Her former staff members helped her shopping in Montana with a Quiltworx gift certificate in appreciation for the quilts they had received in the 18 years they worked together.

As a certified Judy Niemeyer/Quiltworx teacher, Carol is now sewing and teaching paper piecing with Judy's techniques at several quilt shops in the area, and coordinated the construction of this year's CCQ Opportunity Quilt. These beautiful award winning quilts are so much fun to make.

# Judges for the Show



**Kathie Kerler** began quilting in 1988 and judging in 2002. She is certified through the National Association of Certified Quilt Judges and as a Qualified Instructor teaches the association's Two-Day Introduction to Judging Seminar. She is a national award winning fiber artist who has completed rigorous courses in design and embroidery through the City and Guilds Institute of London, England and the Lesage School of Needlework in Paris, France. In 2009 she completed a public commission for Clackamas County for Oregon's sesquicentennial, the state's 150th year anniversary. In 2011, Kathie had a solo exhibition at the Rocky Mountain Quilt Museum in Golden, Colorado. She has also been a featured artist for The Oregon Garden as well as two quilt guilds.

Over a seven-year period, Kathie worked as a contributing editor to American Quilter magazine, writing and contracting over 115 articles and patterns. Currently, she freelances.



**Val Pellens** has been quilting since 2000 and enjoys all genres including traditional, art, and the modern movement. She owned a successful longarm quilting business for 5 years, but retired to pursue her own goals in quilting. Val has been an active member of Clark County Quilters since 2005, including two years as President. Val has won numerous awards for her work and collaborative work. She successfully completed the West Coast Quilt Judging Academy and continuing education with certified judges. She is looking forward to opportunities of judging at a variety of venues and encouraging others to join in her passion of quilts.



**Elizabeth Spannring** began her crafty journey knitting socks, sewing costumes, and decorating cakes. When a sewing friend presented her with a rotary cutter and a bag of scraps, another enthusiastic quilter was born. Entering her first international competition in 2000, she's won numerous awards at major international, regional, and local shows across the US. Having attended the Northern California Quilt Council Judges Training in 2002, she pursued her interest in judging and in 2006 completed the NQA Certified Quilt Judge program. In 2011, she fulfilled the training and coursework to become a certified quilt judge with the Canadian Quilters Association/ACC.

She has served as a judge and juror for a variety of competitions and exhibitions throughout the US and Canada.

Having had the opportunity to participate as an entrant, show organizer, judging floor coordinator, juror, and judge has given her first-hand experience on many levels. Believing that every quiltmaker has a "voice" waiting to be heard, she strives through concise and constructive comments to provide objective feedback to the quiltmaker, recognizing the creativity and expertise of each individual quilter.

Presently she is an instructor and program administrator of the Quilt Judge Certification Program with the Canadian Quilters' Association/ACC, helping to prepare and certify qualified individuals to judge quilt competitions.

# CCQ Block Contest

Clark County Quilters' 2025 Block Contest is Red, White, and Blue Stars. The guidelines were to make a star block using only red, white (or off-white), and/or blue fabrics. Within those guidelines, any techniques could be used. At the end of the show, all blocks will be given to Quilts of Valor to be made into quilts for veterans.

## CCQ Guild Challenge

This year's quilt show challenge is entitled "Give Peace/Piece a Chance!" The guidelines for this year's challenge were:

- the quilt background should be pieced reflecting your idea of peace
- Include a peace sign somewhere on the front of the quilt
- maximum perimeter must be no more than 120 inches

## Fort Vancouver Tapestry

The Fort Vancouver Tapestry Project's mission is to promote historical, regional and artistic education through the creation and exhibition of legacy fiber arts in the Northwest. The Fort Vancouver Tapestry is a surface design embroidered wool-on-linen textile narrative of the history of Clark County, Washington. The 70 linen panels are stitched with mostly wool thread and some metallic threads. The tapestry is 108' long. Many of our guild members worked on this piece of historical art.

## Special Exhibits

Special exhibits are judged, eligible for awards, and considered for Viewer's Choice

**First Time Exhibitors:** This is a member sponsored category that recognizes any quilter who has never entered a quilt in ANY show before. Quilts in this category may be made using any technique.

**Mod Quilt Squad:** CCQ started a modern quilt group in July 2018. We have a roster of almost 50 quilters. We meet monthly and have a topic/program each month.

This exhibit includes two challenges: The first challenge was to create quilt in the "Duckworth" style. "Duckworth" quilts were originally created by Jo Anne Merrill Duckworth. They are quick and easy scrap busting, wonky (or improv) log cabin blocks. After the show, these quilts will be given to Comfort Quilts to be distributed to agencies in need. The second challenge was "Traditional Made Modern." Group members were challenged to take a traditional block and make it modern. This could mean oversizing, rearranging or just putting it in a modern setting.

**Mystery Quilt:** Our mystery quilt last year was a quilt along through Bonnie Hunter and her Indigo Way pattern. Bonnie released the fabric requirements at the end of October 2023. She released the first clue the day after Thanksgiving. The reveal or last clue came soon after New Year's. Each week, what you make is a mystery as well as how the unit fits into the top! The last clue or the reveal is the first chance we had to see what we were sewing.

Bonnie often uses a myriad of scraps from her stash to make her quilts. This mystery had two constant fabrics. Bonnie used red and indigo blue; but our members may have used a different colorway. Please note the differences in borders, layouts and the finished size. Sometimes, it's hard to believe that all the quilts started from the same pattern!

**Storytellers:** Storytelling is a tradition in all cultures, first as oral and pictorial. This group was formed because the artists wanted to continue that tradition by using quilts to present visual stories.

Members CarolAnne Olson, Dianne Kane, Gerrie Thompson, Hedda Wright, Judith Phelps, Kathie Kerler, and Kathy Bovee will share their quilts inspired by the "Monochromatic" and "Neutrals" challenges.

**Thread Tales:** Thread Tales is a group of quilters who read four books each year. They then create quilts inspired by the books. Discussion and activities centered around the books can be videos, food, or field trips, in addition to making a representational quilt.

The Thread Tales exhibit this year includes quilts inspired by: *Prayers for Sale* by Sandra Dallas; *The Women* by Kristin Hannah; *The Lager Queen of Minnesota* by J. Ryan Stradal and *The Year of Less* by Cait Flanders

**Vagabonds:** This year's Vagabond challenge was to select a favorite quilt designer whose work you admire to create an original quilt with no pattern in that designer's style or technique. All of the quilts contain an obvious piece of selected orange fabric to tie all of the challenge quilts together.
